## FINDLATER AWARD IN SOCIAL STUDIES

<b>Source of Award</b>	A bequest by Mr Alexander Findlater.
<b>Basis of Award</b>	The prize is for the best piece of written work concerned centrally with social conditions in Ireland, which are interpreted to include social, economic and political areas of study. The work shall be produced by a student during their enrolment at Ulster University.
<b>Eligibility</b>	Any student registered for a programme of study at Ulster University.
<b>Value of Award</b>	A maximum of £300 cash award
